

POTTERY OPEN STUDIO GUIDELINES & POLICIES

Everyone who uses the Galena ARC Pottery Studio must read and accept the following policies, responsibilities and requirements:

POLICIES

- Open Studio night is offered to adults who have previously taken a Galena ARC Clay Class. Exceptions may be made for those who have proven pottery wheel experience.
- Potters work independently. No instruction will be offered during Open Studio.
- <u>Pre-registration is required.</u> No drop ins as there is limited space.
- To cancel a reservation email artdirector@galenaarc.org. If you cancel 24 hours in advance, or more, you can receive credit for future Open Studio dates or a refund. There is no refund for no shows.
- An area will be designated for storage of your clay and pieces in progress. Items left for more than three months will be disposed of.
- All work MUST be signed and dated. Unsigned work will not be fired.
- Evenings for glazing to be determined based on production.
- Firings will be done by the Galena ARC and occur once we have enough work to fill the kiln.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- All clay and glazes must be purchased from the ARC.
- Your bag of clay must be labeled with your name and date of purchase.
- Masks are still required to enter the building. Going mask free in the studio will be determined each night.

CLEAN-UP REQUIREMENTS (Must be completed by 8:15 p.m.)

- Put your work on designated shelves.
- Place a post-it with your name next to, or inside, wet pots.
- Clay trimming scraps, wet scraps, and "slop" from throwing buckets placed into designated buckets.
- Tools washed and returned to the tool container on your wheel.
- Bats cleaned and returned to shelf.
- Wheels thoroughly cleaned and turned off.
- Used towels in labeled laundry bin.
- · Aprons back on wall hooks.
- Bags of clay tightly closed and stored.
